PUBLIC SYNOPSIS OF MAJOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION

2017

Five (5) Officers terminated for Inability to Perform Duties. Officers could not complete the necessary Training Academy required for employment.

Officer was suspended without pay for thirty (30) days for Conduct Unbecoming a Public employee and insubordination. Officer failed to cooperate with an administrative investigation.

Officer was terminated for Conduct Unbecoming a public employee and Neglect of Duty. Officer was criminally charged with providing an inmate with an implement of escape.

Officer was suspended without pay for thirty (30) days for Neglect of Duty. Officer improperly transported an individual under arrest.

Officer was suspended without pay for fifteen (15) days for Failing to Comply with Sheriff's Orders. Officer brought a cell phone into the jail.

Officer was suspended without pay for fifteen (15) days for failure to follow department procedures. Officer failed to properly log evidence.

Officer was suspended without pay for thirty (30) days for Conduct Unbecoming a Public employee. Officer was involved in a motor vehicle accident while off-duty and was found to be intoxicated.
